




Facility Types Map






Highway Recommendations Map




Public Transportation and Rail Map



Bicycle and Pedestrian Map





NCDOT has requested a Resolution of Support from the Cape Fear RPO **endorsing** the Brunswick County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP).

The RTCC recommends approval of the resolution endorsing the Brunswick County CTP.

Item 13: Title VI Plan Update

As a subrecipient of federal funds, the Cape Fear RPO is required to maintain a Title VI Nondiscrimination Plan.

TITLE VI NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY STATEMENT

"It is the policy of the Cape Fear Rural Transportation Planning Organization (CFRPO), as a federal-aid recipient, to ensure that no person shall, on the ground of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or disability, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any of our programs and activities, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and all other related nondiscrimination laws and requirements."

Item 13: Title VI Plan Update (1 of 3)

Environmental Justice

EO 12898: Federal Actions to Address Environmental Justice (EJ) in Minority Populations and Low-Income Populations

Environmental Justice (EJ) is the fair treatment and meaningful involvement of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income, with respect to the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies.

The Cape Fear RPO "will make achieving EJ part of its mission by identifying and addressing, as appropriate, disproportionately high and adverse human health and environmental effects of its programs, policies, and activities on minority populations and low-income populations."

• This applies to our policies, such as where public meetings will be held, and our projects, such as when we plan to construct or expand a facility.

Item 13: Title VI Plan Update (2 of 3)

Title VI Data Collection

Recipients of FHWA funds are required to identify the characteristics and locations of populations they serve, particularly by race/ethnicity, poverty, and limited English proficiency (LEP).

CFRPO's Title VI Plan includes tables and maps of demographic data, as well as an analysis to determine the LEP language groups present in our planning area and the specific language services that are needed.

Title VI Plan Procedures

<u>Dissemination of Title VI Information</u>: Reasonable steps will be taken to make the public aware of their right and our obligations under Title VI through, including, but not limited to:

- Visibly posting our Title VI Policy Statement in public areas at our facilities, on our website, at our meetings, and prominently in any significant documents and reports we distribute;
- Translating information into languages other than English that meet the LEP safe harbor threshold;
- Incorporating Title VI language into our contracts and agreements.

External Discrimination Complaint Procedures The Title VI Plan outlines a process whereby the Cape Fear RPO will process complaints of alleged discrimination filed under nondiscrimination laws that are applicable to CFRPO programs, services, and activities.

Item 13: Title VI Plan Update

As a subrecipient of federal funds, the Cape Fear RPO is required to maintain a Title VI Nondiscrimination Plan.

• RPO Staff has updated the Title VI Data in the Plan, but there have been no changes to the procedures or policies within the Plan.



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

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
